

**Columbus Arts Marketing Association
Professional Development/Continuing Education Scholarship**

The Professional Development/Continuing Education Scholarship is available to any current member of the Columbus Arts Marketing Association.

There will be up to two \$500 scholarships and several other smaller scholarship awards available each year. Scholarship funding will be considered to pay for tuition, textbooks, workshops, seminars, software and other professional development activities. Scholarship dollars may be used as a match for other promised funds.

Total dollars granted will not exceed \$1,500 within a calendar year. Recipients may not reapply for a period of one year after an award is made.

The selection committee, consisting of representatives of the Executive Committee, will select scholarship recipients based on the following criteria: 1) demonstration of need/desire and appropriateness to continuing your professional development in the field of communications 2) detailed budget 3) current membership in CAMA.

Recipients will be required to submit a two page final report detailing their experience.

**\$500 Scholarship Deadlines: June 1, for the period July 1 through December 31
Dec. 1, for the period January 1 through June 30**

Small Stipend Deadlines: Eight weeks prior to activity start
